



# Optimist Team Selection Trials Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> May to Monday 6th May 2024

#### **Arrival**

Please note that as well as the Optimist Team Selection Trials, the Andrew Simpson Centre have their opening day on Saturday 4<sup>th</sup> May.

The code for Gate Four will be 5562. The gate is accessible 24 hours a day with the code. This code is also for the pedestrian gate to the left of the main building entrance, although this will be open during the day. All the other pedestrian gates have the code C1739.

## Dinghy Park (see the attached site plan for zones)

Please store your dinghies in the following zones.

Dinghies Zone 3 (two boats to one space) Quiet Zone – no support persons allowed in this zone

Zones 4, & 6 (two boats to one space)

Road Trailers Please put road trailers in area marked.

RIB Road Trailers Please put RIB road trailers at the back of the gravel car park, behind the RIB compound.

You may wish to bring a hitch or wheel lock to secure your tailer.

#### **RIB Launching**

Is from R3 Hard vehicle launching slipway. Please do not leave vehicles or trailers on the road leading up to the slipway as Sunseeker do require access.

#### **Parking**

**All vehicles** are to be parked in the **main gravel car park**, over the road, opposite the main building. Please keep the small car park free for windsurf users to access their slipway. Vehicles are only permitted in the boat park to drop off and pick up boats.

#### Reception

#### **Lockers**

Lockers are available. A £10 cash deposit is required to get a key, which are available from Reception.

#### Cafeteria

The Cafeteria is open 08:00 – 18:00 during the event.
