

# Optimist Team Selection Trials

## Thursday 9<sup>th</sup> April – Sunday 12<sup>th</sup> April 2026

### Arrival

The code for Gate 4 will be 1872. The gate is accessible 24 hours a day with the code. This code is also for the pedestrian gate to the left of the main building entrance, although this will be open during the day. The code for pedestrian gate next to gate 4 is C1739.

A one-way system will be in operation to drop off dinghies. **Enter through Gate 4**, drop off your dinghy and launching trolley, put the road trailer in marked area in the Boat Yard, then **exit through Gate 6** to park the vehicle in the main gravel car park over the road opposite Reception. Vehicles will not be permitted in the dinghy park. If launching a rib, exit through Gate 6 and turn **left** towards R3 Hard.

### Dinghy Park (see the attached site plan for zones)

Please store your dinghies in the following zones; two boats per space: 3,4,5,6.



#### Optimists

Zones 3, 4, 5, and 6. Two boats per space.

#### Road Trailers

Please put road trailers by the yachts in the boat yard, labelled Optimist trailer storage. Start dropping trailers off as far into the allocated storage space as possible and fill the area from back to front to maximise on space.

#### RIB Road Trailers

Please put RIB road trailers at the back of the gravel carpark. You may wish to bring a hitch or wheel lock to secure your trailer

## Parking

**All vehicles** are to be parked in the **main gravel car park**, over the road, opposite the main building. Please keep the small car park free for windsurf users to access their slipway. Vehicles are only permitted in the boat park to drop off and pick up boats.

## Reception

## Lockers

Lockers are available. You will require a £1 coin for use.

## Cafeteria

The Cafeteria is open 08:00 – 17:00 during the event. **Only food bought in the café may be consumed in the café and Spinnakers.**

## Water Refill Points

WPNSA encourages visitors to bring their own reusable drinking containers. There are four water bottle refill points: one in the Cafeteria, one outside the toilet corridor and two at the bottom of the Event Hall ramp. You will see these signs next to the refill points:



## Dinghy Park – No Glass or Crockery

For everyone's safety, we kindly ask that no glass or crockery is used in the dinghy park or under the balcony. Many sailors are bare footed or just in dinghy boots walking around, so we want to prevent any cuts from broken glass or crockery.

## Scooters, Skateboards, Segways etc.

We kindly ask that these are not used on site and especially not inside the building. They cause quite a few accidents, not least by the people riding them!

## Use of Drones

## Wi-Fi

The WPNSA Guest Wi-Fi is free to all onsite. It has a bandwidth of 5MB download and 1MB upload. An upgrade of bandwidth may be purchased for £5 per day.
